Who is Eligible?

- 1. Veterans, immediate family members under 18, Caregivers, Widows and disabled adults living in the home with the Veteran
- 2. Be of low-income OR have medical needs that cause regular visits to a medical treatment facility

Where Can I Go?


Our primary goal is to help those needing medical care or services first, but you can use the program to do almost anything *(not all inclusive)*:


- 1. Doctor Visits (not just to the V.A.)

How Does It Work?

1. Eligible person requests ride through the Alamo Service Connection (info@askasc.org) or is referred by a Social Worker, or other Case Management program in the community.



- 2. Rider completes intake & assessment process:
 - Provides supporting information via fax / email to include:
 - a) DD214
- b) Photo ID
- c) other documents as requested
- 3. Rider is approved and provided contact number for transportation provider in their area to schedule ride (At least 7 10 days advance)
- 4. If eligible, ride is provided FREE of charge (Riders can use for multiple trips based on funding)
